## Future Tense

### Going to

Expresses plan for the future

I am **going to** visit my grandpa tomorrow.

### Will

Expresses a sudden decision

I **will** have fish instead of chicken.

Expresses a desire to or agreement to do something

I **will** keep my promise.

Both can be used to make future predictions

She **will** be famous someday.

She is **going to** be famous someday.

Verbs have different forms, called tenses. The tense of a verb tells us when the action happens.

In this lesson, we will learn

- when to use the future tense
- how to form the future tense
- what is the difference between "will" and "going to"

### **When to use the future tense?**

We use the future tense when we want to talk about future actions or happenings.

### **Forming the Future Tense**

#### **Form 1: will + verb**

#### **Examples:**

I **will write** to John.

It **will be** dark soon.

#### **Form 2: am/is/are + going to + verb**

#### **Examples:**

I **am going to finish** my work soon.

We **are going to win**.
