Structure:

• Afirmativesentences:

I-You-We-They = have to

Example: I have to go to the doctor You have to go to the doctor We have to go to the doctor

He -She -It = has to

Example: She **has to** go the doctor He **has to** go the doctor It **has to** go the vet (IT se usa para animales o cosas en este caso los animales no van al doctor sino al veterinario)

• Negative sentences:

I –You –We –They = Don't (do not) have to

Example: I don't have to go to the doctor You don't have to go to the doctor We don't have to go to the doctor

She –He –It= Doesn't have to

Example: She doesn't have to go to the doctor He doesn't have to go to the doctor It doesn't have to go to the vet


