Content:

Uses of have to: We use it in affirmative sentences when we think it is necessary to do something and in negative sentences means it is not necessary to do it / Lo usamos en oraciones afirmativas cuando creemos que es necesario hacer algo y en oraciones negativas cuando creemos que no es necesario hacerlo

Structure:

- **Affirmative sentences:**

I-You-We-They = have to

Example: I have to go to the doctor
You have to go to the doctor
We have to go to the doctor

He –She –It = has to

Example: She **has to** go to the doctor
He **has to** go to the doctor
It **has to** go to the vet (IT se usa para animales o cosas en este caso los animales no van al doctor sino al veterinario)

- ***Negative sentences:***

I –You –We –They = Don't (do not) have to

Example: I don't have to go to the doctor
You don't have to go to the doctor
We don't have to go to the doctor

She –He –It= Doesn't have to

Example: She doesn't have to go to the doctor
He doesn't have to go to the doctor
It doesn't have to go to the vet
